- Florida 511 informed by data gathered in SunGuide
  - Mobile app and web interface
  - Public-facing
  - Helps tell motorists about traffic delays





### **Existing Performance Measures**

- Data for assistance provided by Road Rangers is recorded by Transportation Management Center (TMC) staff in SunGuide under the following categories:
  - Notifier
  - Type
  - Time Period
  - Day of Week
  - Activity





## **Existing Performance Measures**

- Feedback is provided by the public via our Comment Card Program, which tracks responses to questions asked about:
  - Time Services Performed
  - Type of Service
  - How Courteous or Helpful the Road Ranger was
  - Level of Satisfaction
  - Arrival Time from Request
