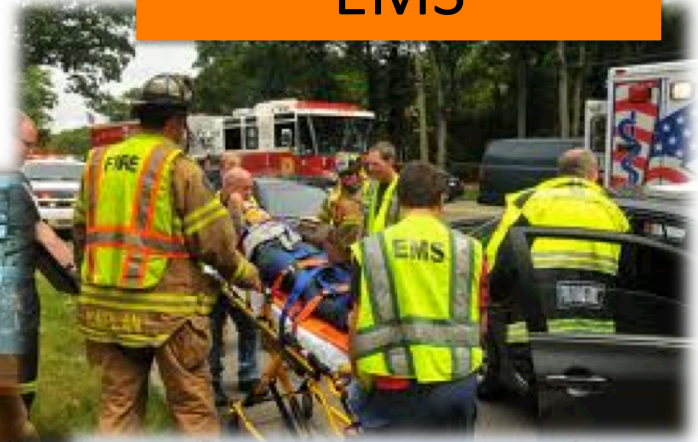
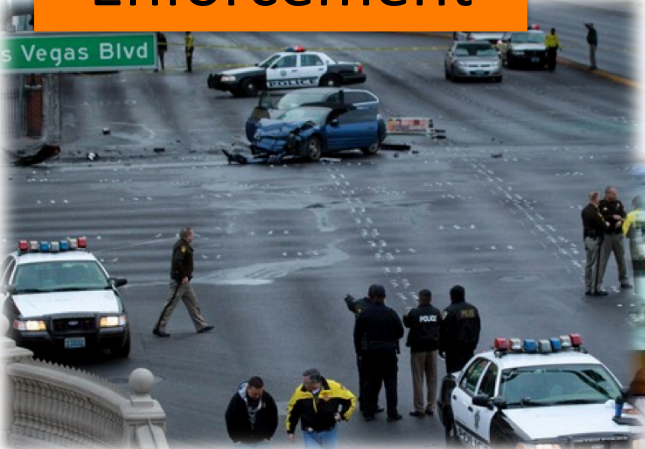

# Focused Training for SSP's

---

- SSP Responders – scouts that are typically roving and patrolling detecting incidents as they occur.
- Often the first on scene, assessing the incident and crafting the Traffic Incident Management Area (TIMA) in the critical first moments of an incident scene, and throughout.
- SHRP2 TIM Training Competencies help with the foundation building of SSP employees and their tactics on incident scenes.



# SHRP 2: National TIM Responder Course

---

- **Objectives:**

- Improved responder safety
- Improved reliability (reduced incident duration)
- Improved motorist safety (reduced secondary crashes)

- **Approach:**

- Researched core competencies
- All disciplines participated every step
- Development of multi-disciplinary training program for all responder stakeholders
- Cross-training in TIM core competencies

## Train-the-Trainer Sessions

- 206 sessions with 7,394 participants



## In-Person Responder Training

- 5,945 sessions with 146,603 participants



## Web-Based Training (WBT)

- 5,227 participants



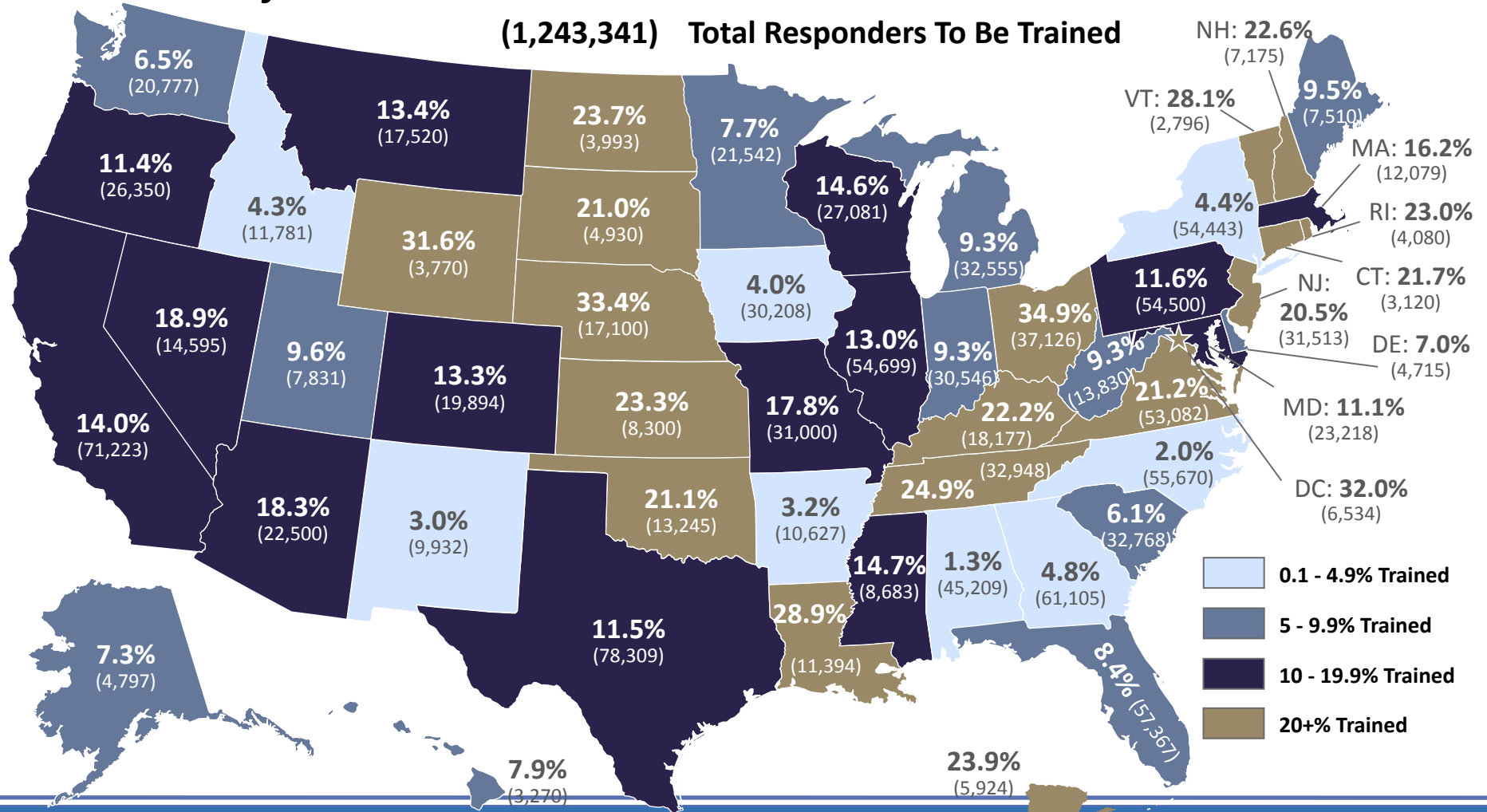

# Total Responders to be Trained (as of 2/22/2016)

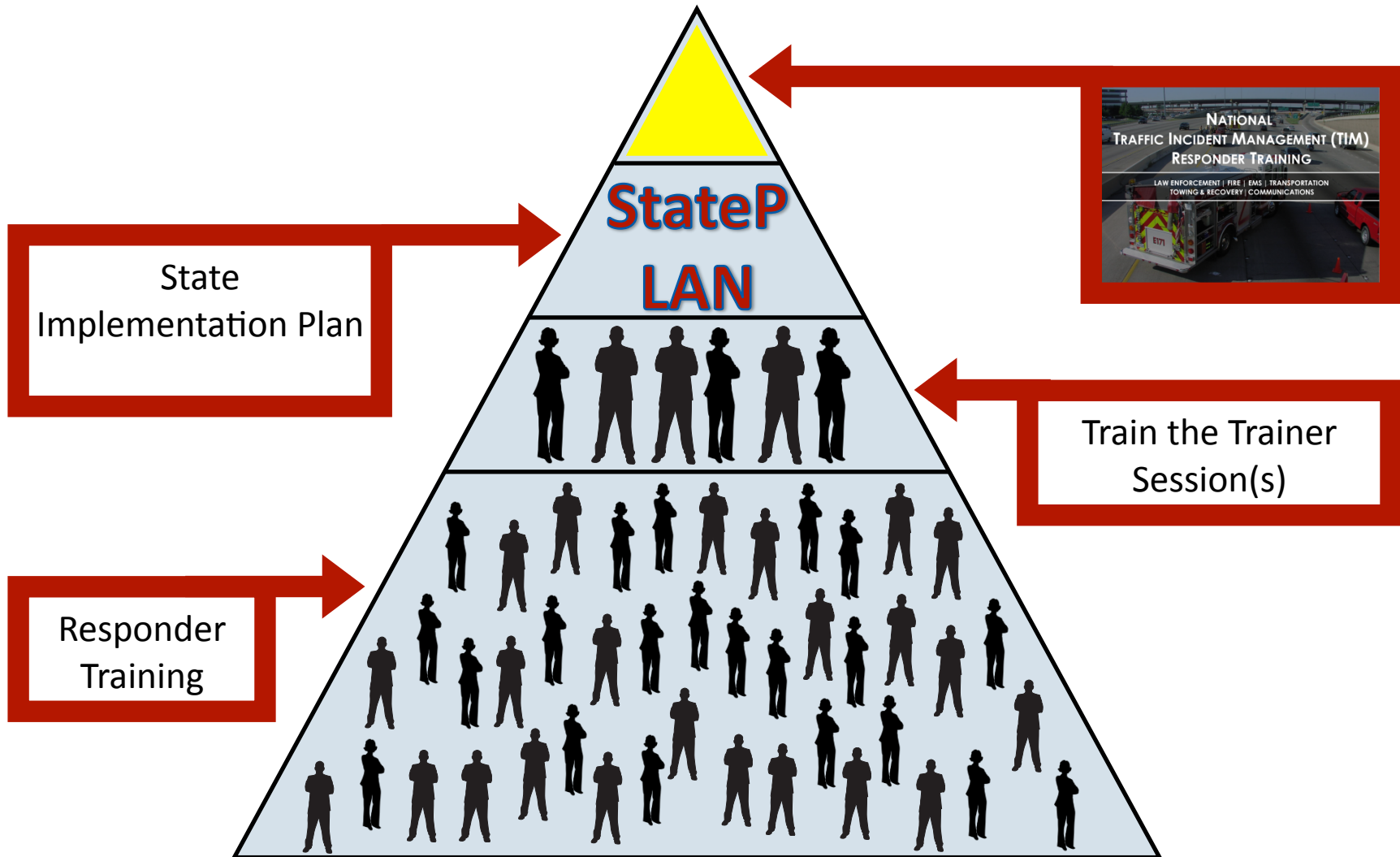
**SIP Goal of 20%**

# Training SSP Staff Best Practices

---

- **Maryland** – CHART Program trained all full time TIM staff with TIM responder training – also several qualified trainers in staff.
- **Georgia** – HERO program extensive training academy for operators that includes SHRP2 TIM Training.
- **California** – TIM personnel trained and focused on maintenance community within CalTrans through a video based California version TIM training.
